EV Charging Payments: Standardizing the Wild West

lan Brown, IFSF EFT Lead, will lead a panel discussion on the challenges of fragmented EV charging payment systems for fleets and consumers. The panel which will include Olivier Sanrey from Mastercard, Holger Kunkat representing EMVCo and Andreas Blin from ChargePoint will discuss how IFSF, OCPI, eMSPs, CPOs, and payment networks can align to support secure, interoperable, and data-rich transactions.

Forging a Future Standard: What We Learned From Creating the Payment API

Juha Sipila, a Senior SME Consultant at CGI and the original author of IFSF's Merchant Initiated Payment API, will present the background and original motivation for developing the API, some pitfalls and lessons learned from the early implementations and what this could mean to future development of API based standards.
